BSL unit 101 is a one-term course over one lesson a week for those with little or no previous experience of BSL. This unit will allow you to gain competence and confidence in the production and reception of BSL; you will acquire basic language skills to facilitate simple communication with Deaf people. You will learn simple, everyday language such as meeting people, using numbers, getting around, and describing the weather.
