#### AS and A Level Exam Results are released on Thursday 16 August

If you have taken external exams this summer, results will be released online via Student Advantage accounts at 8.00am. There will also be a helpdesk running at College. You should check that you can login to your Advantage account in advance of Results Day. #### What to do if you are disappointed with your results

Please consult the information sheet about examination appeals attached to your results slip.

BHASVIC runs a Help Desk on Results Day *and* a Post Exam Results Advice Service, provided by the Guidance Team during the second part of August. The main focus of this service is to support students who have not passed exams. If you are in this situation, then we would like you to make contact with us so that we can support you in your next steps.

Please be aware that there will be very limited advice on the reasons behind results achieved or whether students should acquire their scripts, request remarks or resit exams. This advice is best taken by teachers who return to college and consult with students in September. The Guidance Team's priority will be supporting students who are facing difficulties in continuation with subjects, continuing at BHASVIC or unable to gain their university place; we ask that you allow Guidance time to focus on these students' needs.

# Returning for an A2 Year

We would like to remind you of the conditions for you to return to BHASVIC in September. You must have:

- at least 90% attendance overall and completion of all work set since your return from Progression Exams in June; this includes attendance at all your classes, including tutorial, Progression Day and Careers Enrichment Day.
- passed the equivalent of at least two single subjects, enabling you to continue at least 2 A Levels or equivalent in your second year.
- no outstanding financial debts to the College; this includes any outstanding A1 course charges; charges for new or continuing courses (e.g., Art, Photography etc.) or charges associated with poor attendance.

Please also be reminded that BHASVIC does not offer restarts or repeats of the A1 year due to lower than desired exam results. If you have not met any of the criteria above and were intending to continue studying at BHASVIC, please contact the college urgently.

# A2 Enrolment takes place on Monday 3 September 2018

You are expected back in College for enrolment at **8.45am**. Full details of the day will be posted on the VLE and you must **visit the VLE from Thursday 30 August** to find out which rooms to go to.

The day will consist of lessons in all the subjects which you are continuing. You should bring your summer assignments into college on that day for your teachers to review with you. You will also have an opportunity to get advice from subject teachers about any relevant exam results, possible re-sits and predicted A Level grades.

#### I need to speak to a Guidance Manager or make changes to my timetable.

If any of the following apply to you, and you had not resolved these issues before the summer holidays, we ask you to contact college and make an appointment with a Guidance Manager *before* the A2 Enrolment Day:-

- 1. You have not passed one or more exams that you needed to enable you to study one or more of the subjects you were planning to continue with in September (you must achieve at least a grade E in any AS, Progression or Resit exam which you wish to take through to A2, or pass for any BTEC subject).
- 2. You wish to make complex changes to your subjects, tutorial option or A2 pathway.

# I can't come to BHASVIC in August but need help with changes to my Programme of Study!

If you are away on holiday in the second half of August but need support with changes to your study programme, please do not worry. We ask you to try and come into College on Thursday 30 August or Friday 30 August, when staff will be readily available to help you enrol.

If you require advice and changes to your programme of study but cannot attend BHASVIC until Monday 3 September, again do not worry but please be aware that you may miss vital starter lessons and may have long waiting times to see someone at the Help Desk.

## Compulsory lessons: Friday 7 September, Normal timetable starts from Thursday 13 September

Please make sure you plan your summer accounting for the need to attend College on 3rd and 7th September. Normal timetable and full lessons begin from Thursday 13 September but you are expected to be completing work which has been set on 3rd and 7<sup>th</sup>, in addition to your summer homework.
