

Car Boot Sales at BHASVIC – Welcome to Brighton, Hove & Sussex Sixth Form College’s Car Boot Sales

Procedure for Sellers

Saturday - The sale area opens at

8.00 am until 12.30 pm. Please do not wait on the double yellow lines on the Old Shoreham Road. Cars waiting to enter the sale should wait in the upper car park. The entrance to this car park is in Dyke Road.

Cars can then leave this car park in time to reach the gate on Old Shoreham Road at 8.00 am. Due to traffic restrictions the route to follow is left out of the gate, along Dyke Road, left down the upper drive and then left again along the Old Shoreham Road.

Sunday – The sale area opens at 9.00 am until 12.30 pm. Please do not wait on the double yellow lines on the Old Shoreham Road. Cars should queue in the Upper Drive on the southbound side, where tickets are given out on a first come first served basis at 7.30 a.m. by a car boot marshal. On the instruction of the marshal, cars can then proceed along the Old Shoreham Road to the gate to enter the market.

We do not allow the sale of the following:

- Alcohol
- Stolen goods
- Tobacco
- Pornography
- Weapons

Pirated copies of CDs, DVDs, videos or computer games etc. are also prohibited.

We will not hesitate to contact the police if we suspect these activities are going on.

First Aid

First Aid facilities are available in the site office through the doors into the main building from the lower car park or please contact a marshal (wearing a yellow jacket).

Emergencies

If there is an emergency please contact a marshal (wearing a yellow jacket). They have radio telephones and mobile telephones. The site office is through the doors into the main building from the lower car park.

Car Parking

Please avoid coming by car if at all possible. Car parking is available in the upper car park off Dyke Road. Please comply with parking restrictions and do not park on double yellow lines. The local police and traffic wardens patrol regularly and will issue parking tickets to vehicles illegally parked. Cars parked on Old Shoreham Road in particular cause

annoyance to local residents and this may jeopardise the future of the sales so please help us to make sure they continue by parking with care.

Disabled Parking

Disabled Parking is available at the front of the main building in the area accessible from Old Shoreham Road about 50 metres from the entrance to the lower car park.

Dogs

Dogs are not allowed at the car boot sale – except for guide dogs for the blind.

Rubbish

Please take your unsold goods and rubbish home with you.

What does the College Do?

During the day the college is a sixth form college for approximately 1400 students aged 16 to 19. The majority of these students are following advanced level programmes including advanced vocational courses. However a significant number are taking GCSE, other intermediate vocational courses and a range of other courses in IT, music, drama and sport. Students come from a wide geographic area. While the majority come from Brighton and Hove, many travel from a wide area including Lewes, Haywards Heath and along the coast both east and west.

We receive all our funding from the government (not the local authority) and

this is supplemented by income from such events as our car boot sales.

The college offers adults opportunities to learn languages or computer skills in its Open Learning Centre – to book a free taster session telephone 01273 859802. In the evenings, college holidays and at weekends we open our facilities to a wide range of organisations. We hire out our premises for a large number of activities: social, recreational and sporting including the hall, which can be used for anything from dances to wedding receptions to exhibitions. 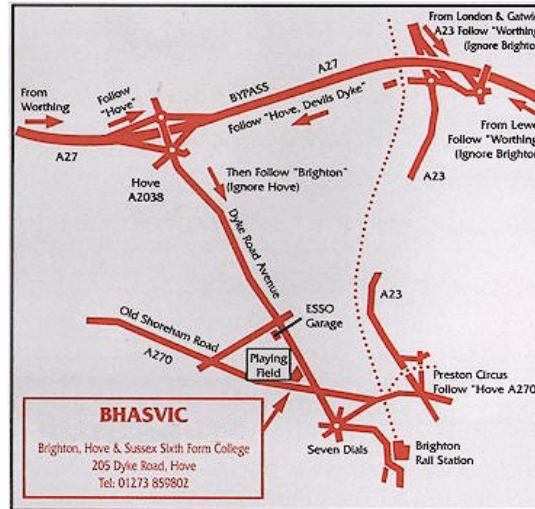
What Happens to the Income
