## About The Awards

Whilst our Education for Life (E4L) Awards are very much a part of the College's present and future, the most prestigious awards we make also commemorate the past. BHASVIC was created in 1975 from Brighton Hove and Sussex Grammar School and our three top awards are named after members of the old Grammar School community who notably, and even outstandingly, demonstrated consideration of self and others in their lives:

The Newton Prize commemorates **Colonel Philip Newton** (1920 -1998), an old boy of the Grammar School who entered Sandhurst in January 1939 and who subsequently saw action at El Alamein. Colonel Newton was awarded the MBE for service during the 1956 Suez Crisis.

**Ernest Beal** was educated at Brighton Hove and Sussex Grammar School and was killed on the Western Front in March 1918 aged 33. He was posthumously awarded the Victoria Cross for going to the rescue of a wounded man under heavy enemy fire, having earlier in the day led a small group of men to clear four enemy machine gun emplacements. Although he survived these actions, he was killed by a shell just the following morning.


**Thomas 'Tommy' Read** was Headmaster of the Grammar School from 1899 -1924. He would have overseen the school's move to the present site in 1913.

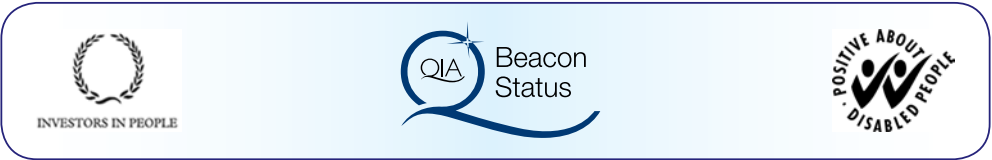
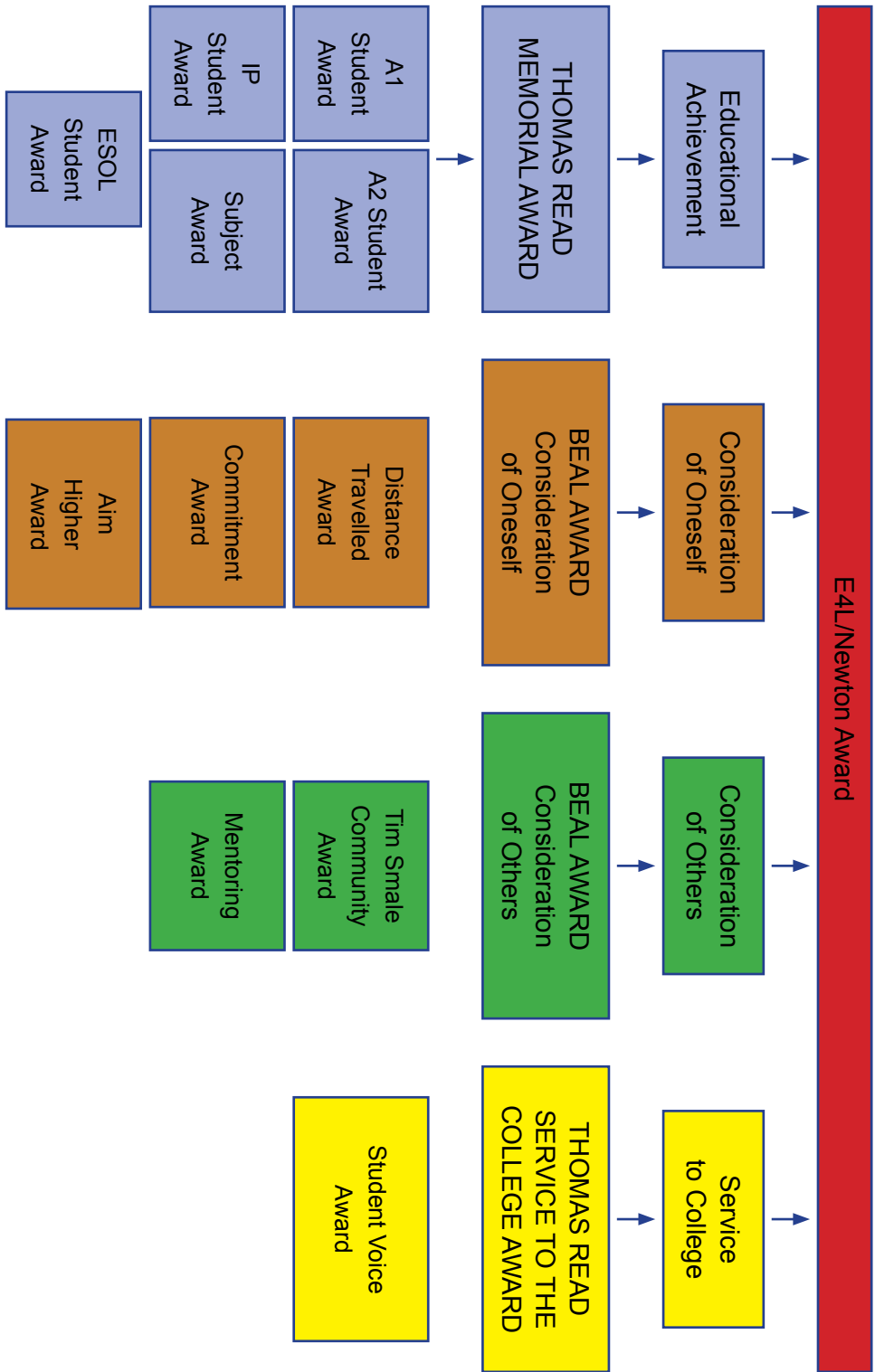
