

PLEASE NOTE THAT A1 STUDENTS WHO ARE PROGRESSING TO A SECOND YEAR AT BHASVIC MUST RETURN TO COLLEGE AT 08:30 ON MONDAY 13 JUNE.

Full attendance until the end of term (Friday 15 July 2011) is required for students who want to complete their A levels in 2012, as A2 courses start then. Students are advised that they should not drop subjects if there is any chance that they might want to take it in September, once their results are known. If they do not attend these classes, they will not be allowed to take that subject. **Students who take holiday in the last five weeks of term, including the Progression Event or the Enrichment Days, are unlikely to be allowed to return to College in September.**

A1 students who are not completing A levels and all IP students should attend the Leavers' Event at 13:40 on Wednesday 29 June.

**Monday 13 June and
Tuesday 14 June**

Progression Event for A1 students. Attendance is compulsory for those who wish to return to College in September. This event focuses on progression to Employment and Higher/Further Education. A1 students will **return** their **A1 books** and will **enrol** onto **A2 courses** on Tuesday morning. On **Wednesday 15 June** a Careers Progression Day organised by departments will take place. A2 classes start this week.

Study Leave for A1 students whilst the Leavers' Event takes place for A2 and IP students and those A1 students who are not returning in September.

**Thursday 30 June and
Friday 1 July**

Study Leave for A1 students whilst the Moving on to BHASVIC Event takes place for new students.

Thursday 14 July

College Enrichment/Challenge Day. All A1 students who wish to return in September must undertake a personal challenge at College on this day unless they have signed up for a work experience placement or are participating in a longer residential trip. Students will have chosen their activity in March.

Friday 15 July

Summer Term ends for students.

Thursday 18 August


AS and A2 examination results available in the Main Hall from 09:00. College staff will be available to offer advice and guidance on possible course changes for A1 students.
