2. Pre-requisites

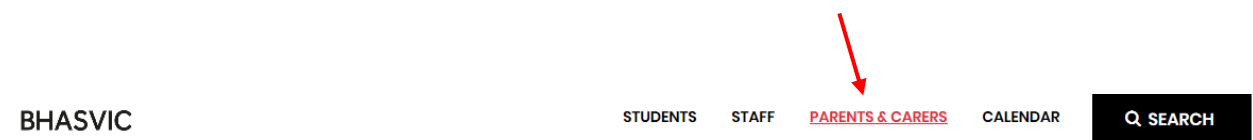
Before trying these instructions, please ensure that BHASVIC is aware of your correct email address and that you have received your Parent Advantage account details.

It is the responsibility of your young person to provide us with up-to-date and accurate contact information so please encourage them to come to us with a current working email address for you.

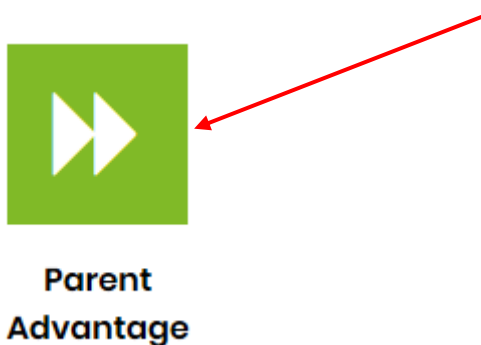
3. Instructions

3.1 Accessing Parent Advantage

From the BHASVIC website home page, select the "Parents and Carers" menu option at the top of the page.



Scroll down to see the icons on the Parent & Carer dashboard. Click the "Parent Advantage" icon.



This will display the Parent Advantage log in screen.

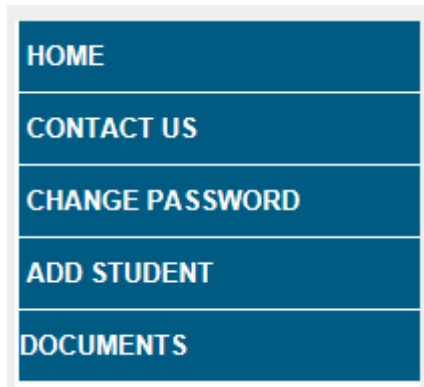
1. How to ... view your young person's Progress Review

Enter your email address and your password. Click "Login" to proceed to Parent Advantage

If you have **never** logged into Advantage, you will need to click "First Time User?" and provide the authentication code sent to you by the College.

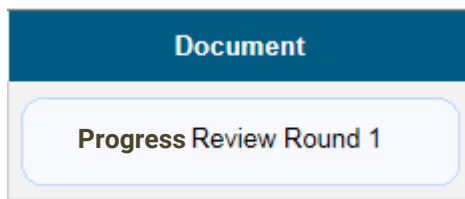
If it is your first time accessing the system, you will need to link your young person's account by going to Add Student and entering the authentication details that were emailed to you.

Click the "Documents" option in the left hand menu.

The main Progress Review document, which includes the student's reflection on each of their courses, their attendance and their teachers' assessment, is available as "Progress Review Round 1" or "Progress Review Round 2", as applicable.
