

Many students continued, or began new employment & apprenticeships including


102 students began an Art Foundation course, many at Brighton Met or Northbrook but some far afield such as Central St Martins





While you are waiting take a look through the workbook and make sure you have saved it.







SACU Test - Results!




Switch between your clouds
