Vietnam Community Development Residential Trip

Dear Parents/ Carers

As part of A level Business and Economics, we are hoping to run a two-week residential trip to Vietnam in early July 2027. We have a great partnership with Projects Abroad who organise educational trips to Hanoi and the stunning landscapes of Mai Chau whilst supporting local community initiatives. Over the two weeks students will be able to immerse themselves in work relevant to their studies (International Business and Economic Development). We expect the cost for this trip to be around £2800.

We have yet to decide the full itinerary for the 2027, but the trip will include:

- Return travel to Vietnam from BHASVIC
- Accommodation
- All in-country transportation
- 3 meals a day
- Clean drinking water
- Cultural and tourism activities
- Community Development i.e. facilitating educational activities, supporting a local charities and environmental outreach
- Travel and medical insurance

If your young person is interested in joining this trip, you do not need to do anything at this stage. We will contact students and parents/carers in the Autumn term with all the finalised details, but we wanted to let you know about this opportunity as far in advance as possible.

All payments for trips are through our BHASVIC ParentPay account, you will be sent details on how to activate your account once your young person has enrolled, we encourage you to set your account up as soon as possible on receipt of these details to avoid any delays later.

Please be aware that students can only partake in a residential that is organised by the department/s that their courses fall under and that due to the number of students / residential places ratio, students will only be able to apply for one residential. Students are chosen by random selection. Please note that if your young person is planning to engage with our Duke of Edinburgh programme then they will be unable to attend a residential as a qualifying expedition occurs at the same time.

We hope that you have a lovely summer, and we will be back in touch with more details in the autumn.
