RELEVANT INFORMATION, WORKS UPDATE

Brymor Construction have been appointed by Brighton Hove and Sussex Sixth Form College (BHASVIC) to undertake the design and construction of the new Digital & Creative Media building located on the Lower Car Park adjacent to the Old Shoreham Road. Brymor is an established, financially stable, and independent regional construction business. Established since 1987, Brymor have grown from strength to strength, now employing over 150 members of staff with a targeted annual turnover of £85 million. As you may be aware we have been working over the 'Summer Holiday' period with an enabling works programme to 'unlock' the main build area within the Lower Car Park. The modular science blocks have now been relocated to the BHASVIC sports field and the new access road part formed and temporary BHASVIC car parking laid out on the existing netball court.

Works have now commenced on the main build area with the initial diversion of existing drainage to enable foundation works to commence.
