Running alongside the curriculum BHASVIC aims to provide enriching trips linked to students' studies that not only bring their studies to life but also encourage independence & an opportunity to make new friends & have new experiences.

As part of the Business and Economics A Level course we hoping to run a weeklong residential trip to China or Vietnam in early July 2025 during Skills Week. At Moving On Day, we did a poll with new students to see which destination they would prefer so we will now go away and work on a detailed itinerary, but we are looking at a cost around £2,000 for approximately 10 days. During the trip, we would expect to visit major organisations/ businesses, learn from the economic experiences of the local population and enjoy sites of economic, cultural and historical significance.

We will contact students/ parents & carers in the Autumn term with all the finalised details, but we are aware that finances are a concern for many at the moment, so we just wanted to let you know about this opportunity as far in advance as possible, so you have time to financially plan if you wish.

All payments for trips are through our BHASVIC Parent Pay account, you will be sent details on how to activate your account once your young person has enrolled, we do encourage you to set your account up as soon as possible on receipt of these details to avoid any delays later.
