## Dear Neighbour,

I am writing to update you with regard to progress on our building project. Since planning was approved nearly a year ago (BH17/03566) we are now at the stage where contractors will soon be on site and breaking ground.

The start date is slightly later than originally anticipated as it has taken some time to find and appoint the right contractor. Our contractors are Brymor and should you wish, you can find more information about them at www.brymor.co.uk. The appointment of the right contractor was crucial and Brymor know that one of our key priorities is to minimise disturbance both for us as a functioning college, but also for our neighbours.

We know from the consultation phase of this project, that one of your key concerns was parking. One of the conditions attached to planning was the need to retain like for like parking on site at any time. You will see from the site logistics plan below (Fig. 1) that we will be using the netball court for parking during the build phase. You will also see from this that the modular classrooms currently in the Shoreham Road carpark will be temporarily relocated beside the Sports Centre, before being completely removed at the end of the build. This vacated space then forms part of our permanent car park as shown on Fig. 2.
