### Coast to Capital

- have identified the Financial and Insurance sector as a priority growth sector in this region. Coast to Capital has important centres for the insurance industry, with large employers in Croydon, Brighton and Hove, Redhill and Horsham.



### The Financial and Business services sector

- Includes a wide range of businesses such as Banking, Insurance, Legal Services, Accountancy and Management Consultancies. It has been a key driver of UK economic performance in recent years and accounts for almost a third of national GVA (Gross Value Added – the measure of the value of goods and services produced in by a region or sector).



### Financial & Insurance sector

- There are 39,000 people employed in the financial and insurance sector in the region, and 147,000 people employed in other business services activity. Overall the sector provides 23.2% of employment in the Coast to Capital region.
