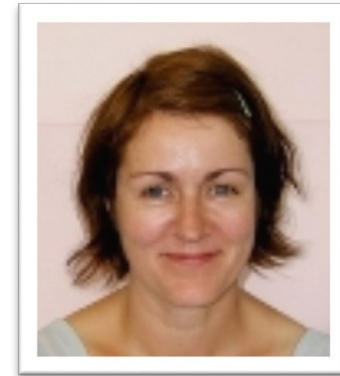
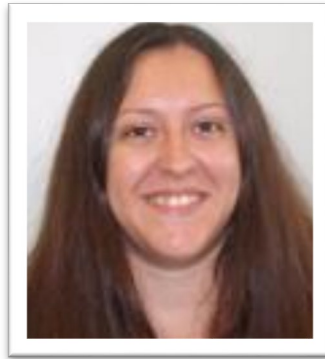
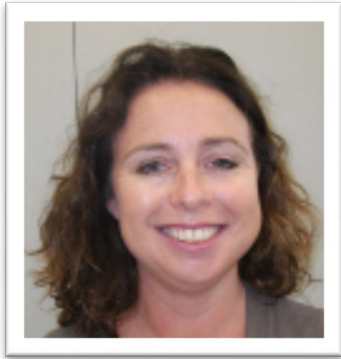
# Building a profile of activities

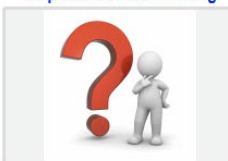

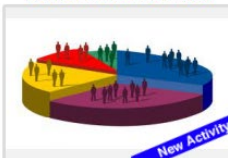

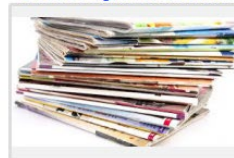
