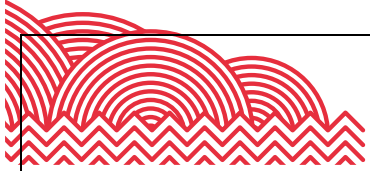

<b>Wo finde ich Geschenke?</b>	finding the right department Getting just what you want Understanding opening times

<b>Wann fährt der nächste Zug?</b>	asking about public transport asking about arrival and departure times buying tickets checking travel details
