NOTES ON ELIGIBILITY FOR ELECTION

1. Parent of a student under the age of 19 (on the date of appointment as Parent Governor) at the College. 'Parent' is defined as natural parent, adoptive parent, legal guardian and step-parent.
2. In accordance with the Instrument of Government of the College, no-one may become a parent governor who:
 - a. is a member of the College staff.
 - b. has been convicted, whether in the UK or elsewhere, of any offence and has received a sentence of imprisonment, whether suspended or not.
 - c. has been adjudged bankrupt, or is the subject of a bankruptcy restrictions order, an interim bankruptcy restrictions order or a bankruptcy restrictions undertaking within the meaning of the Insolvency Act 1986 (3), or has made a composition or arrangement with creditors, including an individual voluntary arrangement.
 - d. Has been disqualified from acting as a charity trustee under the Charities Act 2011 (as amended).

I wish to stand for election as a Parent Governor of the BHASVIC Corporation. I declare that none of the above eligibility exclusions apply to me. For use on the ballot papers, I attach an election statement of not more than 100 words.
