Welcome to the course! For summer homework we would like to create the chance for you to tell us something about yourself and interests through photography. You will do a double sided concertina book with your own photos on SIDE A and found photography, showing inspiration and interests on SIDE B. There is also an online Pinterest task for you to do. This all needs to be complete and brought with you in first week of college.

SIDE A- YOUR PHOTOS

Use the concertina book format to present a sequence of 10 images which tell a story about your-self. You can take the images on any sort of camera, including mobile phones.

IDEAS for your sequence

Autobiographical, about people you know, self-portrait, Culture

Personal space, Your History, Hobbies/Interests, Domestic rituals,

Objects/ possessions, day to day life, a day in the life.

If you are able to print at home or in a shop then that's great but you can also print and present your images when you start in September.

We recommend that you buy a memory stick for the course. This can be used to download and save any mobile phone images to, if you don't print them before the course starts. [we don't have mobile phone leads.]
