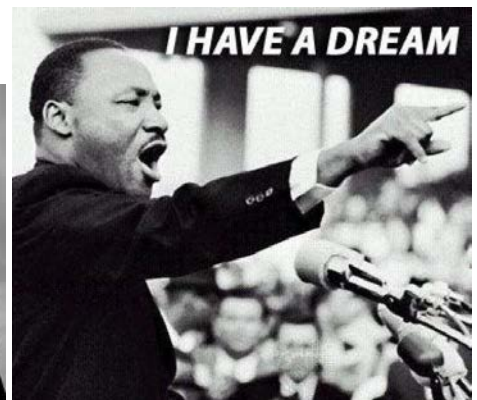
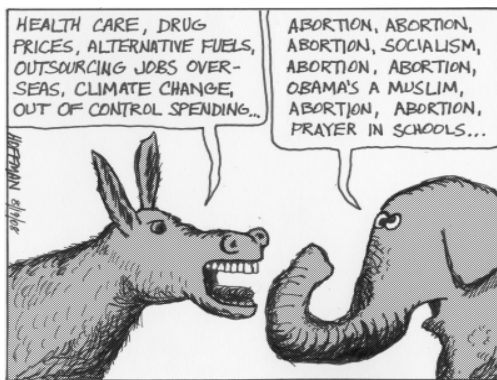


A level politics @ bhasvic 2017-2019

In A Level Politics, all students follow the same course in UK Politics for the first year of the two year course.

For the second year of the A Level, students can choose between American (US) Politics and Global Politics.

You must indicate your choice when you enrol at BHASVIC this coming September. This booklet is designed to help you to decide which option to choose.

Please read the information contained in this booklet and over the summer, consider which option you think you would prefer. Carry out your own research on the listed topics opposite to help you decide.

Please bring this booklet with you to enrolment and be sure to hand the completed section to your enroller so that we can place you in the correct politics block on your timetable.

If you have no particular preference, please make that clear by ticking the relevant box.

Please note that while we will try and accommodate your preference, choices will depend on timetabling and staffing.

- theories of Global Politics, sovereignty and globalisation, global governance: political and economic, global governance: human rights and environmental, power and developments, regionalism and the European Union.
