



 Students join a specialist tutor group to support their progression pathway and application process:

Medical Careers; Visual Arts; Oxbridge UCAS/gap year; Apprenticeships/Employment

- They choose how to make up their final year Study
   Programme to support their progression route:
  - Portfolio course (25 hours)
  - Work placement (25 hours)
