Unit 1 Nice to meet you!	Greetings and proprieties. <i>Как вас/тебя зовут?</i> (What is your name?) Russian names. Professions. Numbers 0-9. <i>Сколько</i> (how much).	Stress and reading rules in Russian. Hard and soft consonants. Personal pronouns (subject and object forms). Gender for occupations. Formal and informal modes of conversation. Negation.	Greeting and introducing oneself and other people. Asking about people's names and who they are. Giving one's own and asking for another person's phone number. Asking for repetition.
Unit 2 My world	Everyday routine, verbs for daily activities. Time. Parts of the day. Numbers 10-100. Family.	1 st conjugation of verbs. Declension of <i>час</i> after a numeral. Possessive pronouns.	Talking about one's family and daily routine. Making an appointment. Filling in a registration form.
Unit 3 In the classroom	Verbs for learning activities. Teachers instructions. Personal things. <i>У меня есть</i> (I have) Numbers 100-1000. Days of the week. <i>Когда?</i> (when?). Events and activities. Plans for the week. <i>Мочь</i> (can, may, to be able to).	Imperative. Possession (the <i>I have</i> construction). Gender and plural of nouns. Conjugation of <i>мочь</i> .	Understanding teacher's instructions during a lesson. Telling about what one has and asking people about what they have/whether they have something. Setting a meeting. Discussing plans for the week.



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Unit 4 In town	Places in town. Directions. <i>Какой? (what kind of?).</i> Adjectives for describing a town. In a restaurant. Menu, making an order. Words for <i>last week/next week</i> .	Adjectival endings. Possessive adjectives. Prepositional case for locations (nouns). Past tense for <i>быть (to be)</i> .	Talking about one's town. Asking for and understanding directions. Buying a transport ticket. Ordering food in a café. Telling about what one did last week/is going to do next week.
Unit 5 Countries and nationalities	One's origin. Nationalities and traditions. <i>Вы когда-нибудь были? (have you ever been?)</i> Seasons and weather. Months. Verbs <i>любить (to love), звать (to call), говорить (to speak)</i> . <i>Говорить по-... (to speak a language)</i> .	2 nd conjugation of verbs. Prepositional case for months. Forming words for nationalities (masculine, feminine, plural). Accusative case for direct object.	Talking about one's origin. Asking a person where s/he is from. Discussing weather and traditions in different countries.
