| My Home | House/flat: parts of a house (walls, doors, windows, etc.), rooms, furniture, everyday activities | Plural form for neuter nouns, irregular forms of Prepositional case | Describing one's home, calling for a master to fix broken things at home, explaining location of things in a house, discussing free time and ways pass time at home |
| Tasty Food | Products and dishes, recipes and cooking instructions, compliments and criticism | Personal pronouns (Dative case) with <i>нужно, надо</i> (to need), Instrumental case after <i>c</i> (with), the future tense | Making a shopping list, reading and writing recipes, talking about food preferences, ordering and paying in a restaurant, inviting people for a dinner and accepting invitations, expressing admiration and criticism |
| Health | Health, mood and wellbeing, body parts, lifestyle, agreement/disagreement, можно/нельзя (it is allowed/it is not allowed) | Dative case with age, mood and state, можно/нельзя, short form of adjectives | Talking about one's health, physical and psychological state, lifestyle, describing one's mood, expressing emotions, asking and answering questions about age talking to a doctor, giving and listening to recommendations |



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| People | People's appearance and character, adjectives describing a person, comparing things, buying clothes (items, colours, sizes) | Adjectival endings, comparative and superlative degrees, Genitive case in possessive constructions | Describing one's own and other people's appearance and character, buying clothes |
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| Transport | Transport, compass (cardinal points), travels, dates, verbs for cancelling, confirming or rescheduling a meeting | Prepositional case with means of transportation, ordinal numerals, Accusative case for destination, Genitive case for origin/departure point | Cancelling, confirming or rescheduling a meeting, ordering a taxi and talking to a taxi driver (price, address, etc.), talking about travels and sites visited, describing departure point and destination (where from – where to), saying where one is from |
