



Student finance guide to Clearing 2019

Whether you're going through Clearing or you've not yet applied for uni or college, it's important to get your student finance sorted as quickly as possible.

1) If you haven't applied for student finance yet

It's important that you [apply now](#) to make sure your money is in place as soon as possible.

2) If your university, college or course changes

If you accept a place at uni through Clearing, you'll need to [log in to your student finance account](#) and update your application as soon as possible.

You'll need to change the university or college on the application as well as your course. You should also make sure you enter the correct tuition fee being charged by your new university or college.

3)If your living situation changes

It's important that you update where you'll be living on your application if your circumstances change. You should do this at the same time that you update your university or college and your course.

For example, if you'll now be living away from home, you'll need to let us know so we can make sure your Maintenance Loan is correct.

After you've updated your application

Your application will be reviewed and we'll get back to you to let you know if there's any change to the amount of student finance you'll be paid.

If your application is based on your household income, make sure your parent(s) or partner give us their income details as soon as possible.
