Blue Stamp Work Experience and Host Stay - Valencia

Please note that this trip is not being run by BHASVIC. This trip has been outsourced to specialist tour operator, Blue Stamp Travel who specialise in educational trips abroad and have arranged a tailor-made trip for our BHASVIC students during Skills Week.

BHASVIC is pleased to offer residential trips to our students alongside their studies as not only does it support their learning but also give a great opportunity to grow independence, develop life skills and make new friends as they move on to adulthood.

The Languages & Culture Department have agreed a tailor-made work experience abroad trip to Valencia, Spain with specialist tour operator Blue Stamp Travel in Skills Week. This is a wonderful opportunity for our Spanish students at BHASVIC to be immersed in everyday Spanish life, language and culture as they will be staying with host families and gaining work experience during the day.

Please note that BHASVIC has outsourced the running of this trip to Blue Stamp Travel, a UK based travel company specialising in European work experience trips for students and schools. Blue Stamp organise the entire package from the work placement, travel, accommodation, social and cultural programme and insurance. No BHASVIC teachers will be accompanying the trip. Blue Stamp Travel will provide a native or fluent Spanish speaker, who will travel as the Group Leader with the students to/ from Valencia. They will visit them in their work placements/ host homes and suggest evening activities for them. Blue Stamp will undertake the supervision, health & safety and safeguarding of students whilst they are away. They are 5-starred reviewed, and ABTA/ ATOL approved. Accommodation

Students will stay at the host family's home in pairs or threes. The host family will provide breakfast and an evening meal. Blue Stamp hosts are arranged via an agent who has a local coordinator in Valencia, and each host and all adults in the household have the local equivalent of a DBS (police clearance) and are visited to ensure that the room and accommodation is welcoming and appropriate. Travel

The return flights are from London Gatwick to Valencia with Vueling or easyJet, with one piece of small personal carry-on luggage (under-seat) and one cabin bag. Students will be met at Gatwick by the Blue Stamp Group Leader and they will travel to Valencia with them. When students arrive in Valencia, they will take public transport to central Valencia where they will meet their host families and then travel to their accommodation at the host family's home. Blue Stamp's Group Leader will take responsibility for their safe travel. Blue Stamp will aim to allocate the flights from the below options to fit in with the proposed budget. We will let you know in due course which flights have been booked.

Work Experience

Blue Stamp will arrange approx. 25hrs of work experience for students. They offer a range of business categories for work experience and will ask students to pick five areas they would be interest to work in. Blue Stamp will then match the students to the business categories available. Please note some categories' availability will depend on the time of year e.g. work experience in childcare would be limited in July as schools have broken up for Summer. Activities

The Group Leader will make suggestions about possible evening activities for students to choose from, some activities will be free, but students should allow a small amount of spending money for activities such as the cinema, local attractions etc.

The cost of the trip is around £1090. Please note that this is the price based on transport arrangements at the time of quotation. The price may change but we will aim to notify you of any changes at the time of confirmation of a place. This includes the following:

- Return flights from London Gatwick to Valencia
- One cabin bag and one small personal (under-seat) bag.
- Airport transfer in Valencia
- Six-night accommodation with host family
- Breakfast and dinner provided by host family
- 25 hours work-experience in a chosen business category
- Group Leader assistance throughout the trip
- BHASVIC travel insurance

The following is not included in the cost of the trip:

- UK airport transfers
- Meals & snacks travelling to and from Valencia
- Activities
- Lunches
- Additional cost for dietary requirements (£35 for gluten free / lactose free / vegan / halal /other)
- Blue Stamp Travel insurance (you will have the opportunity to purchase separately later for approx. £15).

How to sign-up

To make sure that all students interested in joining this trip get a fair chance of getting a place we ask that you complete a sign-up form via this link. Residential sign-up form This does not secure you a place at this stage.

One application per student please and only put the students name down if you are sure they are 100% committed to going on the trip. The deadline to complete the form is by Friday 14 November 2026

If the trip is oversubscribed, we will randomly pick students for the places. We will then email parents/ carers on Friday 21 November 2025 to let you know if the student does/ does not have a place. Those that don't will go on a waiting list. Those with a place will then need to pay the deposit by Friday 28 November 2025 to confirm the place otherwise your place will be withdrawn

Paying the Deposit

The cost of this trip is £1090. The initial deposit is £200.

Please make sure you read the terms & conditions at the end of this letter before proceeding with payment.

Once you have received the email confirming the place on the trip you will be able to log into your BHASVIC Parent Pay account and <u>pay the initial deposit of £200 by midday Friday 28 November 2025</u>. Payment of the deposit secures the place on the trip

*Please note that the £200 deposit is non-refundable, in line with Blue Stamp's terms and conditions. If the deadline is missed for deposit payment, then the place will be offered to a student on the waiting list

Remaining balance

Once the deposit has been paid you can pay the remaining balance of £890 in 3 instalments via Parent Pay by the dates shown below. You can also make intermittent payments before those dates or pay in full.

WHAT HAPPENS NEXT

If your child secures a place on this trip we will pass on the student's contact details along with parental emergency contact details (phone and email) to Blue Stamp so they can make contact with you directly. Blue Stamp will then be in contact to collect information such as passport details and any other further information.

There will be an online trip briefing nearer the departure date where parents and students will have an opportunity to meet Blue Stamp and ask any questions. They will also receive a Trip Pack which will give them all the travel details/ emergency contacts whilst they are away. We will also email this pack to parents/ carers.

Please make sure BHASVIC have your most up-to-date email & you check your junk mail. We will also let students know any information that needs to be relayed to their parent/ carer.

Please note - This is a non-compulsory trip and an enrichment activity. BHASVIC has approximately 4000 students making our course cohorts very large. We are therefore unable to offer places for all students on this trip. If your young person misses out there will be more opportunities for enrichment activities over their two years at BHASVIC.

Terms & conditions

- At the time of writing the cost of this trip is correct. There may occasions where elements of the trip will be affected by price rises which are out of BHASVICs control. In these instances, this cost will be passed to the parent/carer. BHASVIC will make sure we inform the parent/ carer of any price increase in a timely manner & will ensure any additional cost is kept to a minimum.
