Attending academic events/summer schools can enhance your critical thinking and independent study skills and students will be introduced to new subject areas, which will all help to support progression to higher education. There will be the opportunity to ask current students about their university experiences, and talk to academics about their subjects and research. There are numerous benefits to taking part in these events, for example:

- find out about courses and how they are taught,

- use facilities including, labs, teaching areas, sports facilities, library and specialist arts facilities.

#### Summer Schools

For students who enrol on our Access Plus programme, they will have an exciting opportunity to apply for the Summer School Programme. This will give Year 12 and 13 students the chance to study a subject of their choice, produce a university level assignment, meet and network with current Sussex students, as well as explore our beautiful campus. This year's post-16 Summer Programme is now open for applications and will include:

• An on-campus welcome day introducing students to their chosen subject and meeting others on the programme,

• Two online tutorials on the subject of their choosing,

• A two-day residential in Sussex University accommodation where students can experience various aspects of student life, whilst completing and submitting an assignment.

To take part in the Year 12 and above Summer Programme students will need to be signed up to the Sussex Access Programme. Applications to our Sussex Access Programme remain open throughout the year, taking around 5–10 minutes for students to apply. You can check your students' eligibility here, and student can apply using the button below

#### Academic Masterclasses

Access Plus Academic Masterclasses are running between **May and June**, with several sessions available for students to book on to:

• Astronomy Masterclass (Tuesday 24 May) 10:30am – 2:30pm

• Media Masterclass (Tuesday 14 June) 10:30am – 2:30pm

- Life Sciences Masterclass (Wednesday 15 June) 10:30am 2:30pm
- International Relations Masterclass (Wednesday 22 June) 10:30am 2:30pm

These events will take place in person, on our Falmer campus, and give students the opportunity to interact with our staff, academics, and student ambassadors. The University of Sussex will cover the cost of travel to us, and lunch will be provided on the day.

### **National Residential 2022**

#### Deadline for applications is midnight on Sunday 15th May 2022.

Participants outside of the south west of England join our National pathway, which begins with a week-long residential experience – either on-campus or virtual – in the July between year 12 and year 13.

This year, for the first time, applicants can choose between a campus residential or a virtual residential. There are different subject strands available for each, and applicants will be asked on the application form to choose their preferred subject strand and residential type.

#### **Campus Residentials**

On the five-day campus residential, you'll get both the chance to stay in university halls and explore the area around the University of Exeter, and the opportunity to explore a particular academic subject in more detail. Subject strands take place at either the Streatham campus in Exeter or the Penryn campus in Cornwall.

The residential in Penryn, Cornwall, takes place from Monday 4th to Friday 8th July 2022.

The residential in Exeter, Devon, takes place from Monday 25th to Friday 29th July 2022.

#### Virtual Residential

On the five-day virtual residential, you'll explore a particular academic subject in more detail and take part in a group project and virtual social activities. Subject strands take place virtually.

The virtual residential takes place from Monday 18th to Friday 22nd July 2022.

IMPORTANT: We aim to place participants on their first choice of residential and subject strand, but due to demand and availability we are not always able to do so. In this case, we will place participants on their second choice of residential and subject strand. Please do try to choose a residential (campus or virtual) and subject strand (see lists below) for your second choice that you would be just as happy to study as part of the Exeter Scholars programme.

#### Applications have reopened for the following summer schools (closes Friday 27th May)

SOAS summer schools are for students in Year 12. During each summer school students will have a mixture of activities, including interactive lectures delivered by academics, study skills sessions as well as access to resources and materials. Students will also have a live Q&A with recent alumni and current SOAS students and will complete a group project with peers, supported by student ambassadors.

Some of the summer schools will be taking place on campus and some will be offered with a hybrid approach, where you will be able to select whether you attend on campus or via Zoom. Each summer school clearly states which format is being used so please make sure you check that the summer school you are interested in is being delivered in a format suitable for you before you make your selections.

Summer schools are from 10am – 4pm each day, unless stated otherwise.

If you are from outside of London but are interested in attending an on campus programme SOAS will provide unsupervised accommodation and cover travel costs (for eligible students)

During July and August 2022 SOAS will be offering eight summer schools.

For students who attend a UK state school and fulfil at least one of the following criteria:

- First generation in family to attend university in the UK
- Eligible or previously eligible for free school meals
- Experience of local authority care
- From an area of low progression to higher education (as measured by Polar 4 data)
- Anthropology Tuesday 5th Friday 9th July
- School of Arts Monday 1st Thursday 4th August
- Development Studies Monday 1st Thursday 4th August
- History Monday 18th Thursday 21st July

Summer University is a three day non-residential programme for students who are thinking about a career in financial services and are interested in studying related subjects at university. It will give you an insight into the world of banking and finance. It will also introduce the various career paths available to you within financial services, and can help you think about whether a career in these areas is right for you.

Over three days, you will take part in a variety of workshops, talks and lectures led by experts that already work in the industry. There will also be a number of social activities to introduce you to staff and students, and to give you a taste of student life in the heart of the city.

You are encouraged to apply for the Summer University if you:

- Are a Year 12 or Year 11 student as of September 2021,
- Have five 9 to 4 grades at GCSE (or equivalent), including English and Maths,
- Have a broad interest in finance, economics or business,
- Are considering applying to university.

#### £75 per student

Refreshments and lunch will be provided every day and the cost of materials and all excursions are covered within the course fee. Please note: There is no accommodation provided. Suggestions on places to stay are available via the link below.

#### **Bursaries**

There are a limited number of bursaries that cover the full cost of the programme. To qualify for this, you should meet two or more of the criteria below:

- Be living in a POLAR4 area of quintile 1 or 2,
- You are in, or have been in, the care of the Local Authority,
- Receives free school meals.

Applications will be reviewed on a first come, first served basis.

Step into Bath is now open for applications. It is a 2-night residential summer school, from Wednesday 27 to Friday 29 July, for Year 12 students who are on track to meet our typical offer and who are considering applying to Bath for 2023 entry.
