ASPIRING PROFESSIONALS PROGRAMME APP

The Aspiring Professionals Programme (APP) is carefully designed to open up professions for those with the ability to join them in the future, but without the means or networks to get there.

They aim to give young people a real insight into top professions and to provide them with the skills needed to achieve their aspirations. Support is offered through four pillars:

- Mentoring by a professional via email
- Tailored skills sessions and career workshops
- University application support and guidance
- Internships with top employers

Students complete one application to the APP but the strand they are on and therefore how they receive the four pillars of support depends on where they live.

Pathway to Bath Programme

Discover Bath is a free event for Year 12 students from Widening Participation backgrounds to experience university study and find out about life at university.

Discover Bath is a summer programme which aims to give prospective students a taste of first-year life and study at the University of Bath, together with the opportunity to gain an alternative offer (see details below).

Discover Bath is **free-of-charge**, including on-campus accommodation, free meals for the duration of your stay, a programme of academic sessions (lectures, seminars, workshops) and fun social activities. Your travel to the university can be reimbursed (reasonable travel within the UK only).

Discover Bath is available to all **Year 12 (or equivalent)** students who are academically able to study at Bath in their chosen subject and meet <u>our widening</u> <u>participation criteria</u>.

Free Taster Course Programme with Various London Universities (non residential)

The Taster Course Programme provides year 12 sixth form students with a taste of what life at a university in London is like. Through your chosen taster course you will experience the different teaching methods used by university academics and gain an insight into the additional facilities available, whilst meeting students from across the UK.

All taster courses are free to attend and students can choose a course from a variety of subjects taking place at the numerous participating universities. Courses range from voice and drama, to medicine and nursing, to computing and business.

The taster courses take place at various times throughout the year but mainly between February and July. The courses run from half-a-day to a week and are non-residential. All courses are free of charge, students are responsible for their own travel and food expenses, however students claiming a bursary at BHASVIC may be eligible to support with travel.

The courses offer an insight into study at university and the opportunity of attending a course that may be of interest to students who are not sure about at this stage. The experience will also enable students to check out the nonteaching facilities provided by the university. There will be a chance to meet with other students on the taster course and undergraduate students studying at the university. These are great experiences to help with decision-making and with completing personal statements.
